We created Sunfield Center to provide evidence-based and research-informed evaluations and treatments by a team of highly qualified professionals. We are dedicated to increasing awareness of childhood mental health needs as well as providing patients and their families a place that provides stability, trust, education, and ongoing support. All of our staff are trained in the delivery of state-of-the-art assessments and treatments of individuals across the age span (from toddlers to adults) presenting with Autism Spectrum Disorders. We also specialize in diagnostic assessment and treatment of Attention Deficit/Hyperactivity (ADHD) and Disruptive Behavior Disorders as well as Anxiety Disorders in children and adolescents.

Sunfield Center prides itself on the foundation of a team of professionals devoted to the advancement of clinical care, research, education and training. We consult with local academic institutions and hospitals and provide advanced training for professionals, local schools and graduate and undergraduate students. In the coming years, we will continue to focus on building a network of strong relationships with professionals, schools, academic institutions, hospitals and local agencies to provide exceptional care and support to our community and the families we serve.

Population(s) served: Sunfield Center offers assessment and treatment services in three clinical areas.

1. Autism Spectrum Disorders Service (ASD)
2. ADHD & Disruptive Behavior Disorder Service
3. Anxiety Disorders Service

Orientation/Emphasis: Our clinical training model promotes a scientist-practitioner model and focuses on teaching students the integration of research and clinical practice as well as honing the student's skills in the areas of case conceptualization, diagnostic assessment, and treatment planning.

Number of Positions Open: One or two students

Length of commitment: We provide a structured practicum experience with a minimum of 16-20 hours per week of supervised clinical experience and related activities for the duration of at least one calendar year.

Hours per week expected of student: 16-20 hours per week (2 ½ days per week).

Description of Supervision: A licensed psychologist will provide students at least 1 hour per week of direct supervision of clinical work.

Supervisors: (# licensed clinical psychologists) Dr. Suzi Naguib (fully licensed clinical psychologist) is the primary supervisor. Students may also have the opportunity to receive supervision from Dr. Pamela Dixon Thomas and Dr. Barbara Hanna (both fully licensed clinical psychologists as well).

Description:

Services Offered: Individual treatment, evaluation and consultation. Group treatment and professional trainings.

Goals of Training: Students will be expected to develop expertise in the evaluation and treatment for individuals diagnosed with autism and children and adolescents diagnosed with behavioral and anxiety disorders.

Opportunities/Expectations:

Practicum students will initially have the opportunity to participate in co-treatment of individual treatment cases. The student will also participate in comprehensive evaluations conducted with a licensed clinical psychologist. These evaluations include learning how to administer, score and interpret various measures*, and how to write comprehensive reports and deliver patient feedback. In addition to the above clinical experience, students will have the opportunity to participate in a weekly social skills group for adults and/or children diagnosed with an autism spectrum disorder. Students will be exposed and will participate in all aspects of clinical practice including program development, outreach, recruitment and execution. Students will also have opportunities to participate in our professional trainings and to present on various topics in and outside of Sunfield Center.

* Measures include: The Autism Diagnostic Interview Revised (ADI-R), Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule – 2nd edition (ADOS-2), Vineland, Mullen Scales of Early Learning, WISC, WIAT, DAS, K-SADS and SCID.

Two Semester Students: Student will be expected to engage in the above activities with increased independence as the year progresses.
