# Navigating the School System (K-12+)

Your child's teacher requests an evaluation.

Do you have a concern about your child's learning and development and suspect (s)he might have a disability? If so, send a written request to have your child evaluated for services.

Send a written request to

have your child evaluated

to the school principal and

your child's teacher.

# Multidisciplinary Evaluation

If the school knows or has reason to suspect your child has a disability, then they must agree to do an evaluation.

#### 504 Plan

If a child does not qualify under one the 13 special education categories, but still needs supports to help learn in the classroom.

### Within 10 days

Need parental consent to evaluate the child.

# Within 30 school days

The Multidisciplinary Evaluation Team (MET) does an evaluation.

# Individualized Education Program (IEP)

If the child qualifies under one of the 13 special education categories, an IEP will be made. It is a legal document outlining the services the child MUST receive.



# **Team Meeting**

To discuss the results of the evaluation & determine appropriate services & supports for the child.
